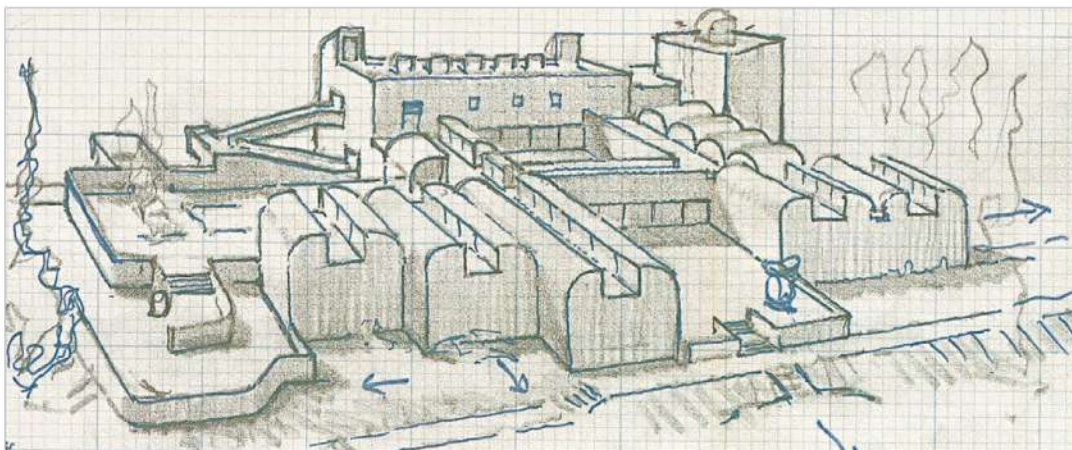

The Foundation exhibits the most important public collection of the work of Joan Miró, in a building specifically designed by Josep Lluís Sert to host the artist's production.

The building was created in a rationalist style with Mediterranean traits, harmoniously integrated into the Montjuïc park. The silhouette of the structure in the Barcelona landscape reflects Joan Miró's expressed desire to create a bond between architecture, art and nature.
